SHS Announcements Regarding Covid-19

The Springs Historical Society wishes to provide the following information regarding our 2020 activities. Our web page and our Facebook site will be updated as Covid-19 requirements affecting our operations change.

Farmers' Market- According to the state of Pennsylvania guidelines, farmers markets are considered life sustaining operations and are permitted to be open. The Springs Farmers' Market season has been extended to be open Saturdays through October 10, 2020, 8:00 am – 1:00 PM unless different restrictions are imposed than currently exist. Should any market dates be cancelled due to government restrictions, vendor payments will be proportionally refunded. Please contact Market Manager Jim Green at (240) 310-2086.

Springs Folk Festival- the festival for 2020 has been cancelled. We are currently planning the 2021 festival to be held Oct. 1 & 2, 2021.
