**Farmers' Market-** The Springs Farmers' Market is scheduled to open Saturdays May 22 – Sept. 18, 2021, 8:00 am – 1:00 PM unless different restrictions are imposed than currently exist. **Springs Folk Festival-** The Folk Festival Committee is planning on hosting the Springs Folk Festival, Friday and Saturday October 1 & 2, 2021, 9:00 am – 5:00 pm both days.
